VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS

OCTOBER 24-25, 2026 | PINE LAKE, GEORGIA | 12:00 PM-6:00 PM

- 1 **Application and approval.** A completed application and payment are required. Submission does not guarantee acceptance. The organizer will confirm approved vendors.
- 2 **Vendor space.** Each space is 10 ft x 10 ft. Vendors provide their own tent, tables, chairs and display equipment. Tents must be securely weighted; ground stakes require advance approval.
- 3 **Fees.** \$125 per day or \$250 for both days. Fees are non-refundable after approval, except if the organizer cancels the event.
- 4 **Setup and operating hours.** Setup must be complete and all vehicles removed from the vendor area by 11:00 AM each day. Festival hours are 12:00 PM-6:00 PM. No early breakdown without staff approval.
- 5 **Permits and licenses.** Vendors are responsible for all required business, sales tax, health and other permits. Food vendors must provide required DeKalb County health documentation before the event.
- 6 **Food and fire safety.** Cooking and open-flame equipment are subject to fire-safety approval. Secure fuel cylinders, keep heat sources attended and have an appropriate working fire extinguisher on site.
- 7 **Products and conduct.** Only approved, legal, family-friendly products and services may be offered. Counterfeit goods, weapons, illegal items and offensive material are prohibited.
- 8 **Electricity and generators.** Electricity is available only when approved in advance. Use outdoor-rated cords and protective covers. Generators require advance approval and must be operated safely.
- 9 **Cleanliness and waste.** Keep the booth and surrounding area clean. Dispose of trash, wastewater, grease and cooking oil properly. No dumping on the event grounds.
- 10 **Safety and access.** Keep walkways, fire lanes and emergency access clear. Follow all directions from festival staff and public-safety officials.
- 11 **Property and liability.** Vendors are responsible for their property, equipment, products and personnel. The event is not responsible for theft, damage, injury or weather-related loss. Proof of insurance may be requested.
- 12 **Weather and enforcement.** This is an outdoor event and may proceed in changing weather unless canceled for safety. Failure to follow these rules may result in removal without refund.
